Investing in Youth for Sustainable Agrifood Systems: Linking Education to Job Opportunities and Sector Priorities

Background

Lebanon's agrifood systems are at a critical juncture. With the country moving forward in its recovery and agricultural transformation, youth engagement and capacity development are central to shaping a more sustainable and resilient sector. The International Centre for Advanced Mediterranean Agronomic Studies (CIHEAM) has played a pivotal role in training, research, and innovation for Lebanese students and professionals for more than four decades. Hundreds of alumni have graduated from CIHEAM's institutes in Bari, Montpellier, Zaragoza, and Chania, bringing back valuable expertise that continues to contribute to Lebanon's agrifood development.

This event, organized by the Ministry of Agriculture in partnership with CIHEAM, aims to consolidate this legacy and invest in the future. It will serve as a platform to reconnect alumni, highlight their contributions, and foster forward-looking dialogues linking education, employment opportunities, and sectoral priorities. This initiative also aligns with CIHEAM's 63rd anniversary, making it a symbolic occasion to reflect on past achievements while charting a vision for the future of youth in Mediterranean agriculture. To respond to these pressing needs, the Ministry of Agriculture, in close partnership with the CIHEAM General Secretariat and Institutes, is organizing the CIHEAM Lebanese Alumni International Seminar, in Beirut, on September 24, 2025.

Objectives

The seminar, under the theme "Investing in Youth for Sustainable Agrifood Systems: Linking Education to Job Opportunities and Sector Priorities," will serve as a platform to consolidate the Lebanese CIHEAM alumni network and to showcase CIHEAM's long-standing contribution to Lebanon's agricultural development and youth empowerment across the Mediterranean. It will spotlight the role of Lebanese youth as agents of change in building climate-resilient, inclusive, and innovative agrifood systems. The program will encourage dialogue on leadership, innovation, and entrepreneurship, feature alumni success stories, and explore opportunities for investment in youth, research, and innovation. The seminar will also promote synergies between CIHEAM and Lebanese institutions to foster new programs, academic exchanges, and collaborative research.

Expected Outcomes

In partnership, the Ministry of Agriculture of Lebanon and CIHEAM aim to mobilize alumni, support youth-led agricultural transformation, and jointly advance the implementation of the CIHEAM 2030 Strategic Plan, notably through the strengthening and valorization of an active Alumni Network. The seminar will celebrate alumni achievements, re-engage them with national priorities, and foster sustainable networking across generations to promote collaboration, mentorship, and knowledge transfer in priority areas for Lebanon's agricultural and rural development. In the short term, it will generate momentum and practical guidance for alumni-driven initiatives; in the medium term, it will consolidate a Lebanese Alumni Network serving as a platform for exchange and partnerships; and in the long term, this Network may evolve into a formal Alumni Chapter, ensuring sustained engagement, reinforcing intergenerational ties, and positioning CIHEAM and its alumni as a lasting legacy of knowledge, expertise, and innovation contributing to Lebanon's resilience and rural transformation.

Participants

The meeting will bring together Lebanese alumni of CIHEAM's four Institutes, the President of the Governing Board & Secretary General, Directors and Researchers of the four CIHEAM Institutes, alongside the Lebanese Ministry of Agriculture and relevant public institutions. Representatives from academia, research bodies, the private sector, experts, international organizations, civil society, and the media will also be present, together with CIHEAM's current students and potential applicants from Lebanon. Diplomats representing CIHEAM Member Countries are invited to join the event.

Panels Description

The seminar includes four roundtable panels, each dedicated to key themes reflecting Lebanon's agrifood priorities, regional opportunities, and the contributions of CIHEAM alumni.

Panel 1: Bridging the Skills Gap: Education and Training for Future Agrifood Systems Transformation

This panel will focus on the skills and competencies required for the next generation of agrifood jobs in Lebanon and the wider Mediterranean. It will address the mismatch between educational outcomes and market needs, emphasizing the role of CIHEAM in updating curricula and fostering stronger partnerships between universities, technical and vocational education providers, and the private sector. Discussions will also highlight pathways to strengthen youth employability and prepare them to lead the transition to sustainable agrifood systems.

Panel 2: Harnessing Innovation and AI to Drive Youth Entrepreneurship in Agrifood sectors

The second panel will examine how innovation, digital transformation, and artificial intelligence can empower young entrepreneurs and strengthen cooperative development in Lebanon. It will present success stories of youth-led agritech initiatives and explore how incubators, accelerators, and financial institutions can provide opportunities for scaling up. The panel will also highlight the importance of building digital literacy and entrepreneurial skills among young professionals to create sustainable agribusinesses.

Panel 3: Catalyzing Research and Innovation for Sustainable and Climate-Resilient Agriculture

This panel will emphasize the importance of aligning agricultural research with Lebanon's most pressing challenges, including climate change, water scarcity, food safety, and agroecological transformation. It will also explore opportunities for strengthening research cooperation between CIHEAM Institutes and Lebanese institutions through joint projects, collaborative networks, and shared platforms. Discussions will address barriers to translating research into policy and field-level solutions and will focus on building innovation ecosystems that actively involve youth and rural communities.

Panel 4: The Alumni Voice: Inspiring Journeys, Collective Impact, and Future Engagement

The final panel will give the floor to CIHEAM alumni to share their professional journeys, reflect on the role of CIHEAM in shaping their careers, and exchange views on how to build stronger collective engagement including through an Alumni Network. Discussions will also highlight success networking stories from Lebanese academia.

Closing Session

The day will conclude with a wrap-up and closing session that will synthesize the recommendations from all panels, identify follow-up actions, and capture alumni commitments for future engagement with CIHEAM and the Lebanese Ministry of Agriculture.
